Our mission is to create dry and off-dry hard ciders in a wide range of styles from traditional and hard-to-drink to modern and highly quaffable using heirloom apples and other carefully chosen ingredients, all reflecting the historical position of hard cider in America and the bounty of the Pacific Northwest.

HALLELUJAH HOPRICOT: A Belgian wit-style cider made with classic American apples, steeped with coriander, bitter orange peel and paradise grains, and fermented with a French saison ale yeast. On top of that rich base, pure apricot juice is added. This cider is finished with Oregon-grown Cascade and (whenever available) Amarillo hops. A fresh and fruity concoction not dulled by sweetness. Off-dry, ABV 6.9%.

REVELATION NEWTOWN PIPPIN: This is a single variety cider with no adulterations. Carefully selected white wine yeast is used to let the particulars of the Newtown Pippin apple shine through. This apple is the granddaddy of heirlooms, beloved by Thomas Jefferson who, speaking from France, said "they have no apples here to compare to our Newtown Pippin." Off-dry, ABV 6.9%.
